Since we will not have scores, promotions will be based on consideration of other factors; classroom work, grades, assessment scores, etc. A summer school program will be held for students working below grade level.

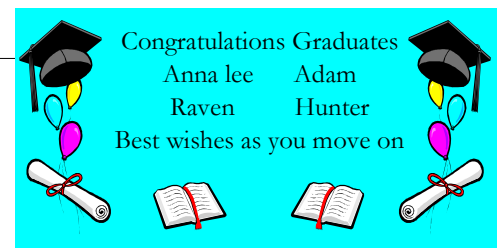
