Grades 3-6 State Testing Schedule

The state has updated the testing window for the grades 3-6 students. ALL students in grades 3-6 are required to take the assessments to measure academic achievement and growth. We are currently working on a plan to test all students from campus learning and eLearning. As soon as it is approved we will share it with you. To date, Reading for grades 3 and writing for grades 4-6 will be April. Math for grades 3-6, Reading for grades 4-6, and Science for grade 5 will be in May. Please do not plan vacations, nor appointments during this window. Our goal is to do most of the testing in the mornings. Keeping with our opening plan, we will keep the two populations of students separate. Look for more information to be released after the training with BPS in March.
