Teacher's Report – Ms. Heidi Murphy

K (room 4) is working on respect, being a good citizen, kindness. They are also working on geometry. For reading they are working on middle sounds and reading comprehension. 1st and 2nd grades (Room 7) is working on water cycles, heating, states of matter. For math they are also working on addition and subtraction, for reading they are doing their review week, spelling, punctuation. For 1st and 2nd (Room 8) We are focusing on all thing's earth and space for science, we are doing a lot of reading activities until the end of the month, for social studies we are doing African American History. For Math place values strategy, and concepts, subtraction and regrouping. 3rd and 4th grades, focusing and reading for the portfolios, vocabulary, drafting and editing. In math they are focusing on multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and measurements. In social studies, they are learning about levels of government, reporting the news, and for science they are focusing on the science fair, survival, fossil and renewable energies. 5th and 6th grades, 5th grade is working on geometry and fractions, they are also studying the atmosphere and stars.
