### **Treasurers Report:**

Diana Hernandez and Cristina Wright balance: \$10,212.49. Mrs. Turner asked PTO to think about what projects they would like PTO to fund for upcoming year 2024. She made recommendations to have a covered walkway to connect both buildings. This would give shelter for the staff and kids during rainy weather and it would also give a more defined cross walk for safety.

### **Vice President's report** - Alicia Savela
